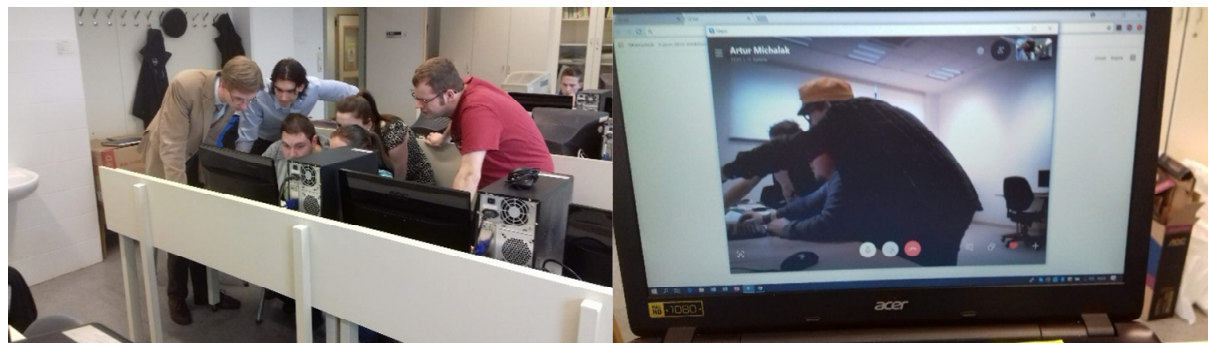


Report on the Polish-Hungarian University EChemTest Battle

We are sorry to announce the fatal results of the Hungarian group at the BSc-MSc EChemTest battle held on 5th April 2019. As usually, our national group became self-confident during the warm-up battle, where the set was won by us with huge odds (85% to 83%). This overall knowledge on Everyday Chemistry (30 questions in 15 minutes, solved in one group) showed both the quick thinking and group working qualities of our students, especially on the colouring additives of salmon. Unfortunately, the endurance was not enough for the 60 minutes individual tests (30-30 questions in analytic, physical, organic, inorganic, biological and everyday chemistry, solved by one-one students). Furthermore, the Polish group was able to aggressively attack us when only 4 of them competing, because two of them did not arrive according to the information restrictions in Poland. The final score was 4:3 for Krakow. We asap need revolution in our chemistry teaching.
